DIRECTIONS From I-94: Take I-94 to Hwy. F South. Hwy. F turns into North Street. Continue on North to St. Paul Avenue. Turn right on St. Paul and continue for

1 mile to Kensington Dr. Right on Kensington and Oak Hill Terrace is the first building on the left.

From I-43: Take I-43 to Hwy 164 Exit. Head North on 164. Turn left onto Hwy 59 and follow to Hwy X (St. Paul Ave.). Right on St. Paul to Kensington Drive. Left on Kensington and Oak Hill Terrace will be the first building on the left.

The Training Center is located on the back side of the building. Pass the main Oak Hill Terrace circle entrance on your left plus one additional driveway and you will see the training center sign. Follow the directional signs.
